UnPlugged



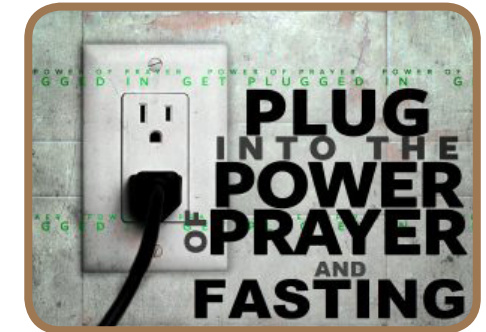
Unplugged kick off their new Season with their monthly lunch on **Sunday 28th January**.
